**Ulrica Schenström** is a Swedish political Analystics and Commentator, Communications Advisor and a politician for the Moderate party as Chairman for the Moderatkvinnorna. She was earlier Cabinet Secretary/Deputy Minister for Prime Minister Fredrik Reinfeldt 2006-2007.



**Hans-Christian Hagman** Dr Hans-Christian Hagman is Senior Adviser to the State Secretary for Foreign Affairs of Sweden. Head of strategic analysis at Foreign Office.



**Anders Wijkman** Anders Wijkman is a Swedish opinion leader and author. He was elected to the Swedish Parliament already at the age of 26. He left politics in 1978 to become the Secretary General of the Swedish Red Cross. In 1999 Wijkman was elected member of the European Parliament. Wijkman is together with Professor Ernst Ulrich von Weizsäcker Co-President of Club of Rome and a Councillor of the World Future Council. He is member of several Swedish and International Academies. Chair of Climate-KIC, the largest public-private partnership on innovation for low-carbon solutions in the EU.



**Magnus Meyer** Magnus Meyer is CEO for WSP Sweden and Nordic. WSP is the Global Analysis- and Technology Corporation with 35 000 employees. From 2000 to 2005 was Magnus managing GE Real Estate's Nordic Business, followed by being CEO for Architect firm Tengbomgruppen for eight years.



**Uffe Palludan** Economist Uffe Palludan is owner of Copenhagen Institute for Future Studies and was former Head of Research at Centre for Future Research, Copenhagen, for 19 years. He won Sydsvenska Dagbladets Europe Prize 2002, the year after Göran Persson, Swedish PM.
